Scholarships

The cost of the 2019 ISRA (Monday, June 10–Friday, June 14, 2019) is \$295 per student, which includes daily lunches and a t-shirt. Several different scholarships are available for the 2019 ISRA, including:

Need-Based Financial Scholarships: Limited need-based financial scholarships in the amount of \$270 are available for the 2019 ISRA from the Illinois State University Center for Mathematics, Science, and Technology (CeMaST). Need-based financial scholarships are based on the following two criteria:

1. The student is currently approved for free or reduced-price meals at their school. *Approval for free meals might have been based on the student being in a household that currently receives benefits from Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), and/or is a foster child under the legal responsibility of a foster care agency or court. Reduced-price meals may have been approved if the student's household income is within the reduced-price limits on the Federal Eligibility Income Chart effective July 1, 2018–June 30, 2019.*
2. The date the completed 2019 ISRA Application Form and 2019 ISRA Reference Form are received.
